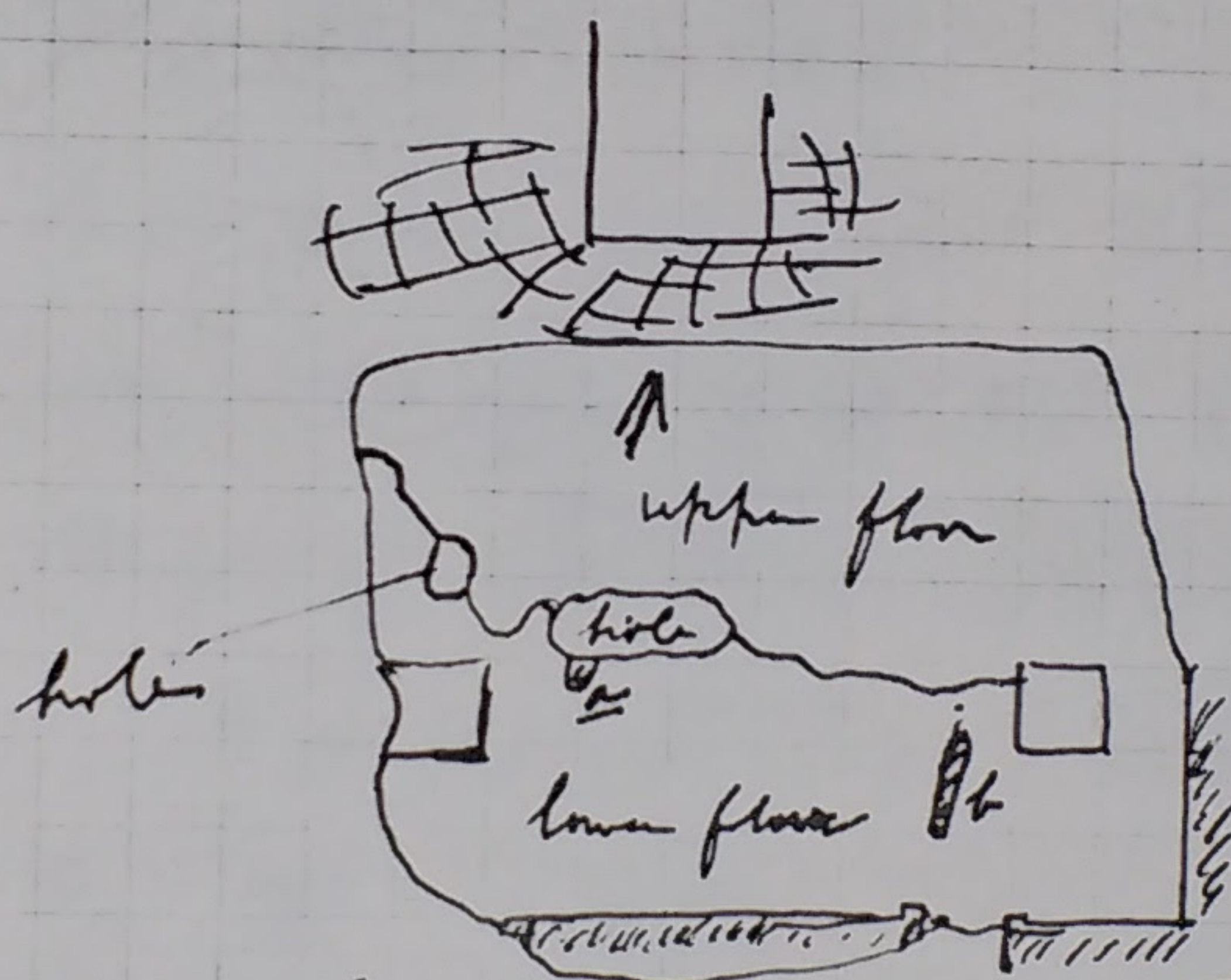

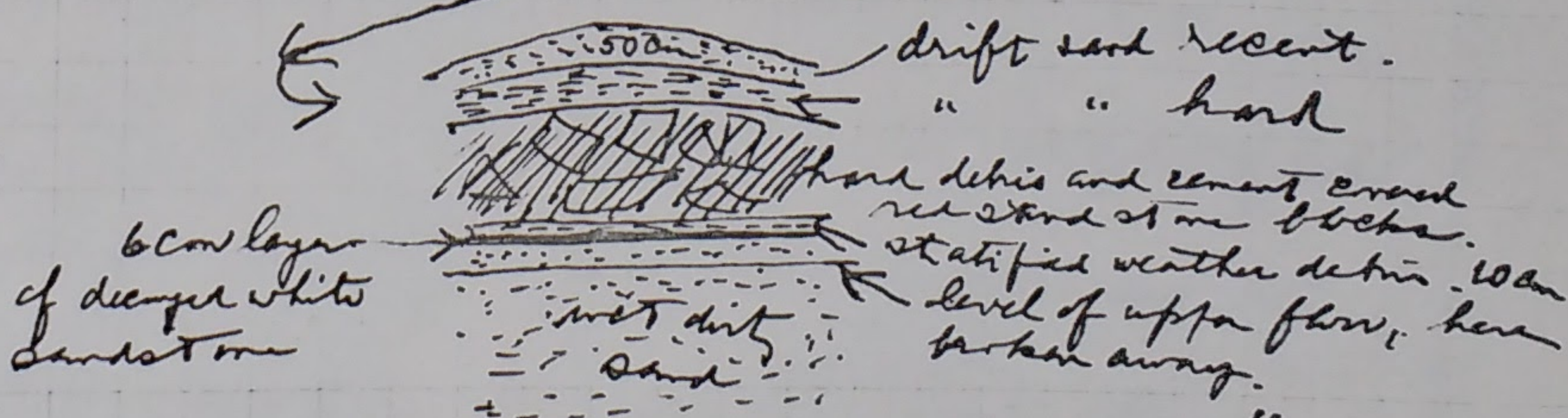
⑧ Trench A. Clearing floor above statues

At present I can only say that the "upper floor" corresponds to that in Building 100 and represents the last ancient occupations of the site. The lower floor (under the statues)

represents the Tarkian - Early Aethiopic occupation. The sand between probably accumulated during the abandonment of the site bet. the early and the late Aethiopic (Nubian) periods.
