Ascending to this, the door from room 904 to sub 806 was walled up when the red 800 was constructed, but may have been still accessible from 905. All efforts to discern foundation deposits which might date either 800 or 800 sub have failed. A comparison o fthe masonry with 700 suggests that red 800 was built by Atlanersa and restored by Senka Amun Seken. It is not possible that the statues in 904 and 500 A were carried out by Atlandersa or Senka Amon Seken for the obelisk of Atlanersa in red 801 seems to have been thrown out at the same time and <u>the group contains two statues of Senka Amon Seken who was later than Atlanersa</u>. When the statues were cleared out of the great temple (500) room 904 must have been clear as also red 801.
