Stratification shows natural slope of decay from wall thus: --

I continued on plan of B 502, "E" end.

Dec 13th Saturday

77 locals

4th Day of Work: -- (1) Continued clearing "S" of doorway into B 502, opposite, "E", + "W" therefrom

[Drawing]

A = 3 places where floor appears, all on about the same level (ca. 1m. below door sill.)
 a whitish sandy surface, perhaps sort of coarse plaster. B = frag. of burnt
 brick wall. Thickness the length of 2 bricks, laid thus: -- [Drawing] at about
 C = circular rim of white + pink sandstone masonry: 50cm. above
 perhaps a wall -- not yet clear. D = Continuation of A.
 mud brick enclosing wall, partially exposed last
 season :-- surface A seems to be the one on which this was laid down.

At x in redûm at level ca 30-50 cm. above A following stone frags.
 of statues: -- (1.) black gran. frag. of leg (calf?) of approx. life sized figure.
 (2) Frag. grey gran. statue-back support [Drawing]
 (3) " " " " -2 plane surfaces
 forming a right angle. (4) small bl. gran. dip[?].

Also found in redum 2 frags. (head + torso) of 2 different shawbti figs.
 green glazed pinkish body faï, poor work. Also 10 frags. green gl. faï.
 two of a thick walled model canopic jar, about 7 of a small thin cup or
 bowl.

I continued on plan of B 502, "W" end.

Dec 14th Sunday

80 locals.

5th Day if Work: --

Work continued "S", "W", and "E" of doorway into B 502. (1) Area
 "E" of line from door to Railway and "N" of mud brick wall, which I
 shall call "B 502 EX 1". (2) Area "W" of line from Door to Railway
 and "N" of mud brick wall, as far as opposite "W" end of B 502,
 which I shall call "B 502 EX 2"

(1) Started clearing area inside coping marked "C" yesterday. This appears
 to be a well. Although, aside from the incomplete sandstone coping
 already noted. There appears to have been no brick or stone lining.
 Reached depth of ca 5m. in damp black earth, unfinished.
