Pyramid XI (Cailliaud PI. XLIX <u>k</u>; PI. LVII, left middle) is the largest pyramid in the southern group (Cailliaud "sud-est"). In his day part of the casing was still visible at any rate on the north. The stones have been used in the Moslem cemetery (and elsewhere).
