river; and, when we tried to cross over opposite
Nuri, we got amongst sand banks and
only after moving about ^{for an hour} and sending
Abd-el-Mezid wading did we manage to
get over. Found our donkeys and the
camels for the Crawfords at the saguiat
of Khan Mohammed Abdullah. Rode to
the pyramids in blinding sand storm.

This field is the most important
of all the pyramid fields in the
neighborhood. Assuming that the
royal group Piankhi, Taharka, Erapahut,
who are buried in this region, their
royal cemetery would be the most
important one in the region. Up
to the present then the probability is
