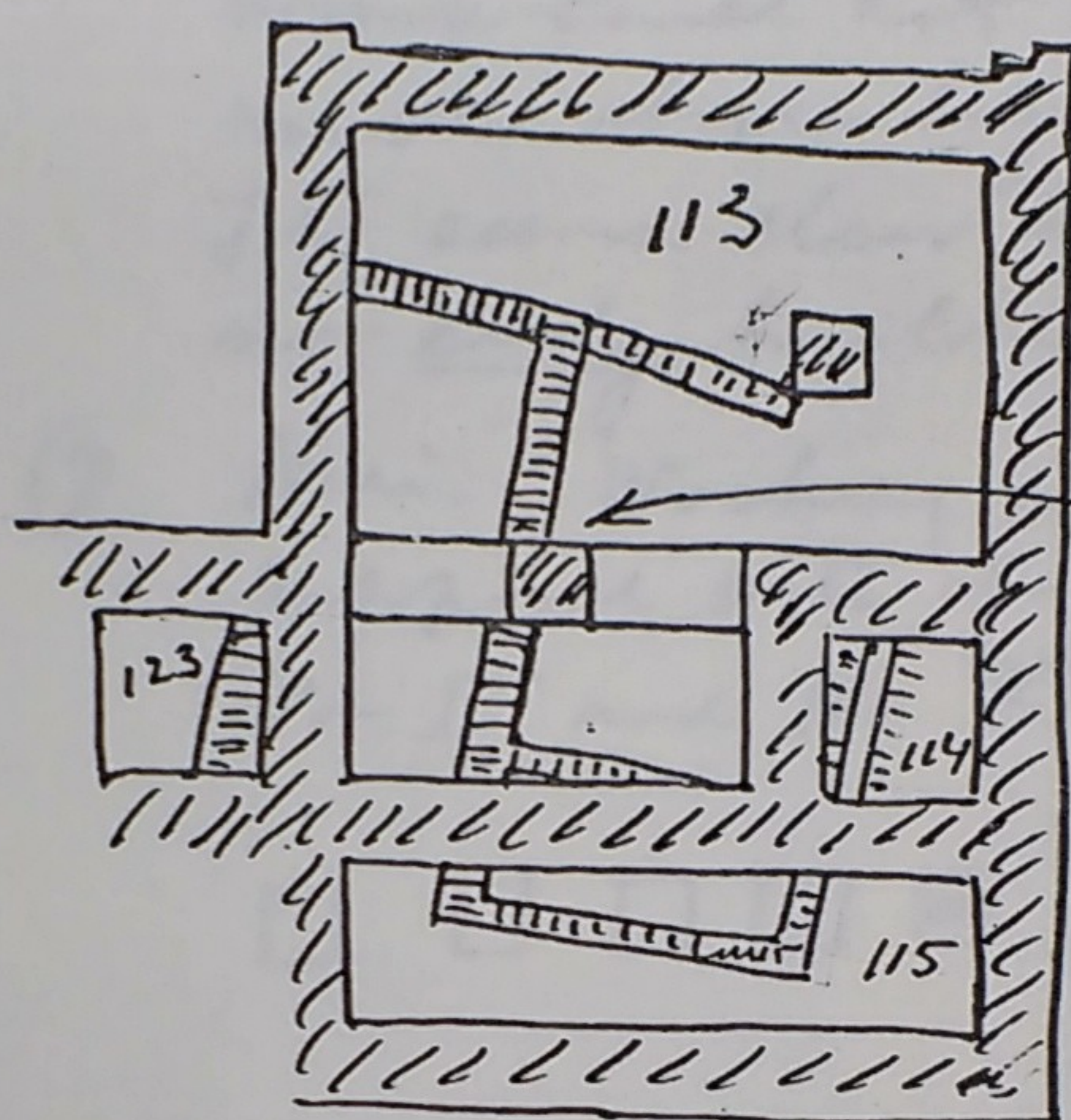


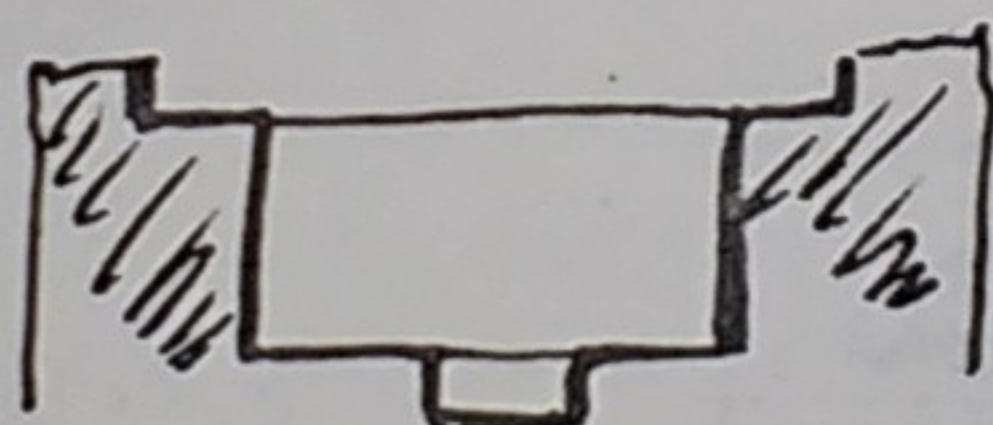

The walls in 113, 114, 115, are only foundations
— no doorways are visible. The
pottery resembles the Baskal Pp.
wares but with ^{some} different forms,
some similar. In 112, were
frag. of several B.F. bowls (not
M.E. Kerra B.F.). The floors of
these sub-rooms must have been
only a little below the floor of 100.
Below the walls is a thin layer
of dust and dirt and then
alluvial sand and mud. The
earth is now very damp and
