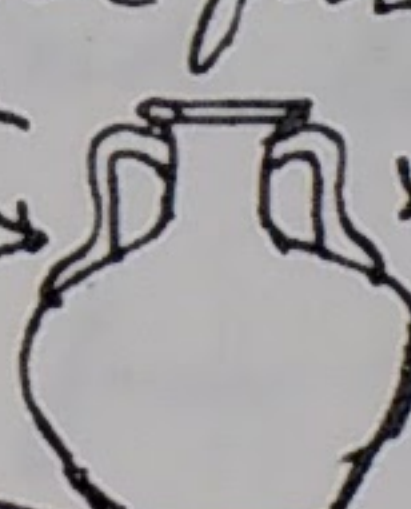

The chapel  is the single chamber
type, but is no longer so well preserved
as shown by Cailland. Traces of plaster
show it had been sized and painted. Remains
of col. show that there was probably a
vestibule to the chapel.
