Dec. 29 Arrived Halfa about 10 a.m. Transferred to train. Sleeper waiting as usual. Mr. Deane and Mr. Jackson of Customs very kindly put through our baggage without opening 18 large pieces, 15 small pieces. Our six Egyptians were vaccinated. Saw Mr. Parker (who went with us to Abu Hamad), Mr. Warder, Mr. Tibbetts (governor Halfa), and Mr. Bayley. Everybody most kind and helpful.

Tuesday,
Dec. 31 Left Abu Hamad at 7:30 and arrived at Kareima 5:45 p.m. Letter from Col. Jackson. The Sirdar who came in on the 28th has gone on to Argo but comes back on Jan. 9. Saw Mr. Siftan[?] who showed us a telegram from Capt. Mil--[?] proposing to visit us on Wednesday Jan. 8. Got all baggage over to camp just under true east face of Gebel Barkal.
