Am preparing to leave next (173)
Monday April 24. As the work
for cases has not arrived, Said and

Work ① 900; ② 503 and 504; ③
Nuri.

① At 900 cleared the rooms 907, 908
to the old store basement. In the
dumped debris in the rooms, several
wrought iron offering jars  and
other small objects. These jars
are probably of the same use as
the pottery jars of similar form
(little two eared earthenware).
These rooms appear to have been
accessory rooms of the old mud-
brick temple 800 sub.

② Clearing rooms 503 and 504. Debris
as before. Also cleaning up the
rest of the rooms 509-520.

③ At Nuri, as it is impossible to
penetrate room B in pass. VII (owing
to the fall of the roof) until the
rotten rock and debris is cut away
from above, I decided to postpone
