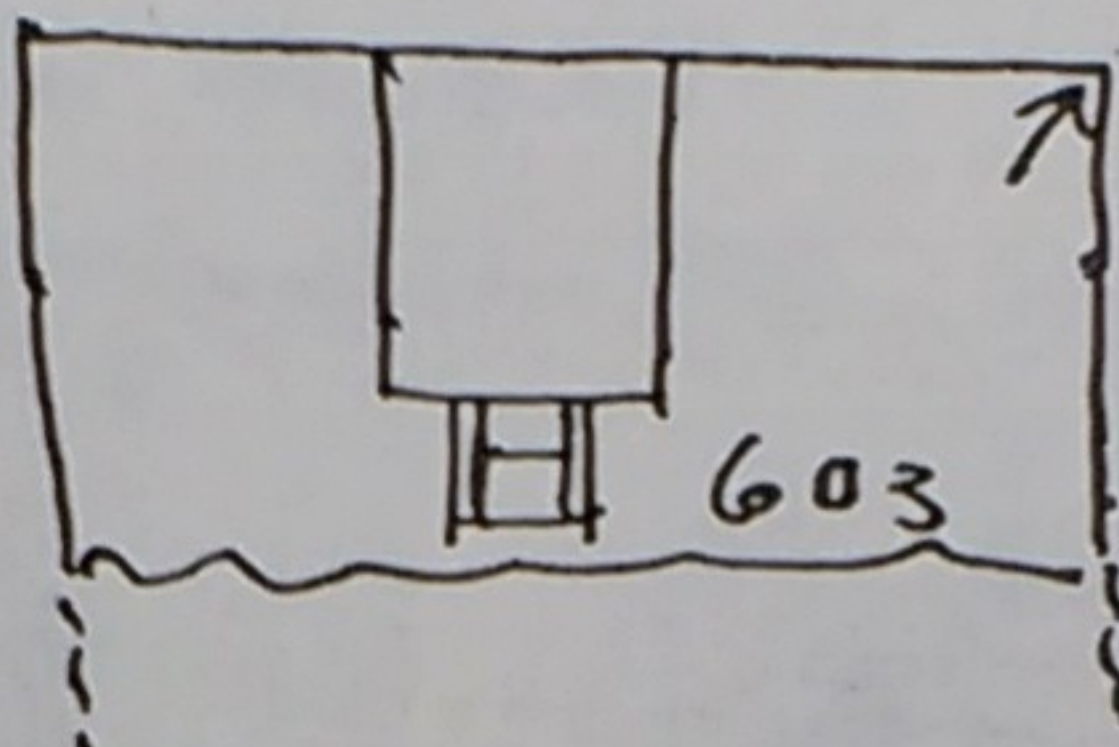


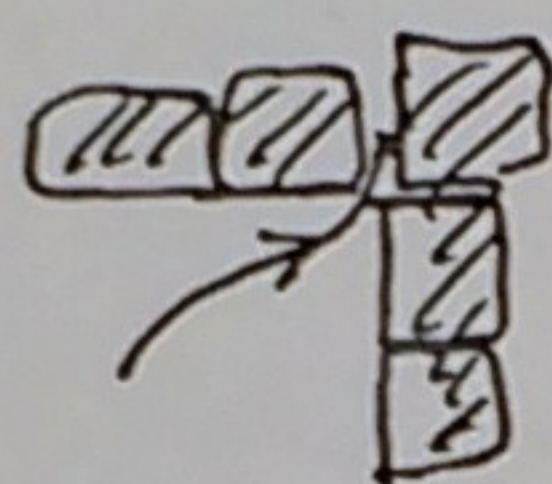

dirty debris mixed with mud and
broken mud bricks, stones, etc.
This disturbed stratum runs under
601. Under this stratum and
directly in front of 601, in the red
same bank, was a shallow burial,
entrance on right side line G-H (due
West) (West is locally called East
coast of river). If G-group people
were also confused by flow of river,
this burial has G-group orientation
as well as position. The grave was
filled with clean red sand and
