(64) In 801, had small gang examining the floors and working at the lines of the foundations of the mud brick walls. Fortunately the mud-brick walls descend 30-50 cm below the floor of that period.

(2) At 900, clearing bank of debris U.-side of 904-6. Trying to get lines of stone wall under the mud brick in 903.

Have now examined all the corners of 900 for foundation deposits,--in vain.

- (3) In the great well (?) 1000, we are now going down through drift dirt mixed with heavy stone blocks. On the R. side we are down ca. 400 cm.
- (4) At 509 and 510, clearing continued (two Egyptians and 8 locals). In 510, another ½ x 1 ell block with the beginning of a cartouche of Ramses II. [DRAWING] Also a large roofing block (broken in two) lies on the floor of 510 and came beyond any question from the roof of this (or possibly 509 or 511). This roofing block of grey sandstone has the usual flying vulture and above the
