The one large pyramid is about the size of Barkal XI. The pyramids are not on very high ground and the chambers have probably been affected by moisture. The rock looks bad.

Returning to Sheikh's house, saw rough stone walls and mud brick walls in edge of cultivated land—perhaps same date as pyr. Floor about 90-100 cm below surface. Tops of walls ca. 30-40 below surface.

Beggar girl—wandering as a result of recent famine at Debba. More dancing. Coffee flavored with cloves at Omdeh's house and also milk, sugar and tea. Distribution of cloths to dancers, and money and biscuits.

Walked back to boat. Omdeh keen to have us work pyramids. Invited him to see work at Barkal.
