- (2) Finished clearing uneven gebel surface on the G. side of 900. Found small frag. bk granite statue, four late potsherds.
- (3) Still clearing great well (1000).
- (4) Still clearing room 509-511. Frag. grey granite statuette—side of head.⁶⁴
- (5) Removed torso of Amun-amal statue from 500 A.
- (6) Stopped work at Z. The heavy mud brick wall⁶⁵ does not seem to belong to the period of 100 but to the Pyramid age. I deem it therefore unwise to make a dump here.
- (7) Nuri Pyr. VIII. The thieves descended through the stair filling at the R. end of the stair, through a small shaft to the door of the chamber,--exactly as in the pyramid at Barkal. [DRAWING] The doorway
