This is the first evidence that these chambers contained valuable furniture apart from gold ornaments.

(4) Continued work on stair of Pyr. V (Budge's Pyr.) Stair steep; steps high.

(5) Continued work on stair of Pyr. VII.

(6) Continued work on stair of Pyr. VIII. Cleared thieves hole in front of Pyr. and worked on E face. In the thieves hole was a frag. of a <u>uraeus</u> cornice from the chapel. Apparently the upper step [DRAWING] was <u>incased</u> below the top of the lower step. The lower step was filled with red gravel etc.

(7) Continued trenches a'-d' W of Bldg 700. Early in the morning Moharib found <u>under</u> one of the stones in trench d', a number of objects,--torso of very small statuette with royal apron) of rough work,<sup>32</sup> several stone rings [DRAWING] bracelet form (C- and X-group Nubian), some with smaller hole (perhaps unfinished)
