- ⑥ Of the two "pyramides mines" of Guilland, the western (Lepsius no. 2), we have numbered XVIII and the eastern (Lepsius no. 1) XIX.

The man being sent to work on No. XIX observed the stairway ^(in passing) to No. XVIII, and exposed the edges of the shaft for about a metre.

- ⑦ Worked on No. XIX, clearing the shaft which was found at once and clearing the E face.

N.B. We have now found 16 pyramids (or traces of pyramids) in the southern group and have opened 15 entrances all on the S. side. No. XXIV has not been examined for its entrance. Every one of these has been plundered in ancient times, but not one in modern times.
