(5) Clearing chamber of XV. Here a curiously decorated vessel of black ware, burnished brown surface, incised pattern decoration¹⁵ [DRAWING]. Also frag. gold foil, and misc. potsherds (Meroitic).

(6) Clearing Pyr. XIX and stair. The casing is preserved below. Stepped. Corners

missing. The chapel is preserved to a height of two courses. Traces of relief (man on throne) on one side. Red sandstone. The stair descends a few steps, then comes a level place, then a pit. The stair enters a lower level, from the slope.
