The sides of the doorway to 501 are broken down.  
The dark debris under the sand is quite wet.  
Rough clearing of I 1 to 4,  
II 1 to 4, III 1 to 4 is finished and we are  
pushing along late floor in IV 1 to 4.  
In IV 4, the end of the stone wall of the  
kiosk(?) noted by Cailliaud has appeared.

(1) B 200  
Jan. 13.

Work continued at B 200, but no  
more masonry was found. On examining  
two stones inscribed in relief found some  
days ago, noted that one bears the signs  
That is ([Drawing]) or ([Drawing])  
The stone is  
sandstone\*. The work is  
very good and the pieces  
could only come from B 200  
in case they had been reused  
in that temple.  
\* drab sandstone sized with  
plaster of paris (signs cut only in  
plaster)

(3) B 1200  
Jan. 13.

Continued examination of B 1200.  
Every point is now clear except the continu-  
ation of Wall I "S" of "NW" corner  
The "NW" corners of I and II appear identical  
and it may be that in the "W" wall I and  
II so coincided as to be indistinguishable.  
II and III are separated by 5-10cm of debris and  
IV has disappeared.
