- (2) After finding triad, near X; the gang was shifted to Pyramid IX and the debris was partially cleared from this (Cailliaud Pyr. I in southern group) See Pl. XLIX I and Pl. LVII on left. In Cailliaud time this pyramid was practically intact.
- (3) Work continued on XI. In the bank of hard sand on the east, was a [?] pit with a small skeleton (child) badly destroyed. [DRAWING] It being manifest that the eastern face was not preserved started clearing southern side between XI and SV. Revealed part of retaining wall of core of XI and struck the edge of a shaft (3) just west of middle.
- (4) Clearing away low mound of rubbish east of XVI which I have marked XVII (on p. 49). This is the western pyr. marked by Cailliaud "*pyr. ruinés*". Only traces of the superstructure preserved is a single course of rubble filling, on which the eastern side
