some nodules (manganese?) such as are found in sandstone, etc. Also a frag of bluestone, inscribed [DRAWING: hieroglyphs] Thothmes IV (or an Aithiopian king of same name??).³³ These are all in loose debris. As no walls were appearing in a' and b', I called over the two Egyptians from a' and b' and put them in to help Moharrib clear the wall in <u>d'</u>. The wall seems to continue [ARROW] NWest about 2-3 m.; but I doubt whether it belongs to any building. As c' is near d', continued work there trenching in to
