(55) and stone thieves that there is no hope of finding any objects but I think we may unravel the order of the walls, probably their respective dates, and partial plans of the original buildings. The area will then become available as a dumping ground for work next year.

(5) The lower stone pavement in 500 A, is made of stones $26\pm \times 52\pm$ cm (i.e. $\frac{1}{2}$ Egypt. ell by 1 Egypt. ell). and are both white and yellow sandstone. Thus the type of masonry, etc. is exactly like that of the room 700 sub. [DRAWING]. These belong to one of the early periods and are undoubtedly contemporaneous.
