- (Feb. 5) This pyr. was not noted by Cailliaud but was by Lepsius (Pyr. 6).
- (6) Of the two "pyramides ruines" of Cailliaud, the western (Lepsius no. 2), we have numbered XVIII and the eastern (Lepsius nr. 1) XIX.

The men being setn to work on no. XIX observed the stairway to No. XVIII in passing and exposed the edges of the shaft for about a metre.

- (7) Worked on No. XIX, clearing the shaft which was found <u>at once</u> and clearing the E face.
- N.B. We have now found 16 pyramids (or traces of pyramids in the southern group and have opened 15 entrances on the S. side. No. XXIV has not been examined for its entrance. Every one of these has been plundered in ancient times but not one in modern times.
- (8) Continued work on Building 100, on rooms 111, 112, 121.
