Heavy wind came up in the night relieving us after the heat of the last two days (max. bet. 109 and 110 Fahr.) Came up in the launch against the wind and got a wetting from the heavy spray flying from the bow. By bringing the Diary to Barkal to be written up, we are now able to get away from the House about 6:30 a.m. We leave here about 5 or 5:15 p.m.

(1) At 900 we cleared away the late floors (apparently surfaces of decay) in 801. Under these was the deposit of fine drift dirt in which was found the head (in the GD quarter of the room).
