Work continued at Building 500 Trench A. The clearing over the Meroitic floor is now 22 ½ m (N-S) by 17 meters (E-W) but we are still some 5 m from the pylon. Fragments of the corner moulding of the pylon [DRAWING] are appearing. They have been cemented after the manner of Building 100, but over a weathered surface. That means the cementing represents a late Meroitic restoration of the temple after a
