(1) "W" of Pylon I B 500 : --

March 17th

551

Work continued as yesterday. The removal of
stone debris + fallen blocks from the "S" half of
"W" face of Pylon was nearly completed, and work
was started on the "N" half, removing surface sand, and
exposing head of the 1st Ram "W" of Pylon in the "Northern"
row. The "N" wall of the late Aethiopean or Meroitic structure in
front of the Pylon was also partially exposed, and there
are latter Meroitic walls (stone rubble and red brick) in
the space between the two Aethiopean walls : --

a-a-a = granite rams in position

b-b = Aethiopean red sandstone curtain walls, forming approach
street.

c c = Contamination of b b beyond the "door jambs".

d = corner of red brick, not yet clear.

e e = Meroitic stone + rubble walls parallel to b b.
