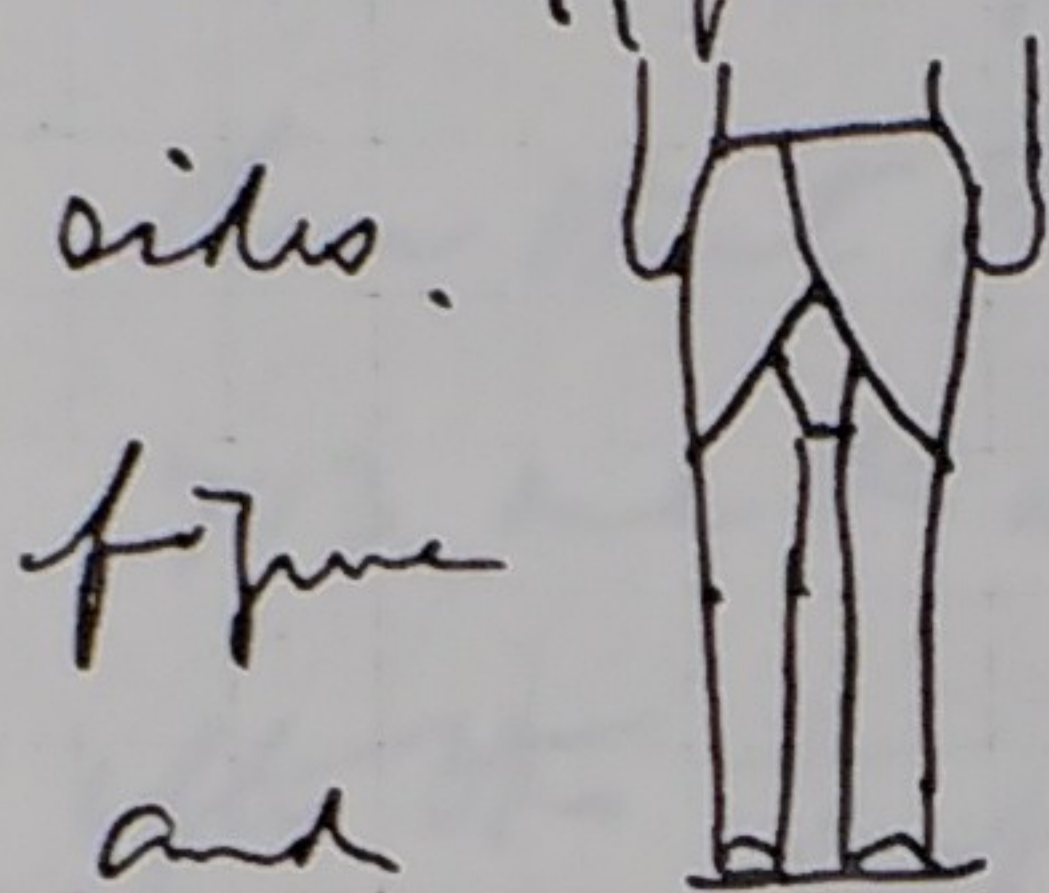

sides.



The work is crude. The
base traces of steen
color. Perhaps the

gold foil found in dirt was on this figure.

6-7 Two (O) are there; one green fair.

Most careful search failed to show
face of no. 1. The stone in the door
way was clearly later. So I moved
it; found a white floor underneath
about 10-15 cm below floor of nos. 1 & 2.
