On the east face of the N. end of the great temple (500) began examining the debris along the outside of the wall. Bldg. 500, Trench D. There is a clear restoration here [DRAWING]. A well-laid wall (mortar) of small stones of uniform size, is built on a roughly built wall of larger stones (dry-laid). (later note:--wall of larger stones built against wall of small stones).
