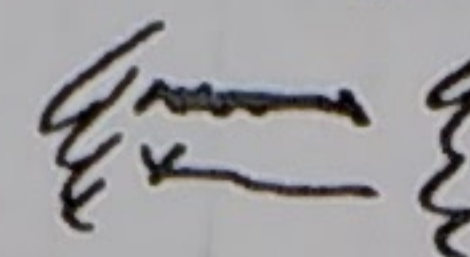


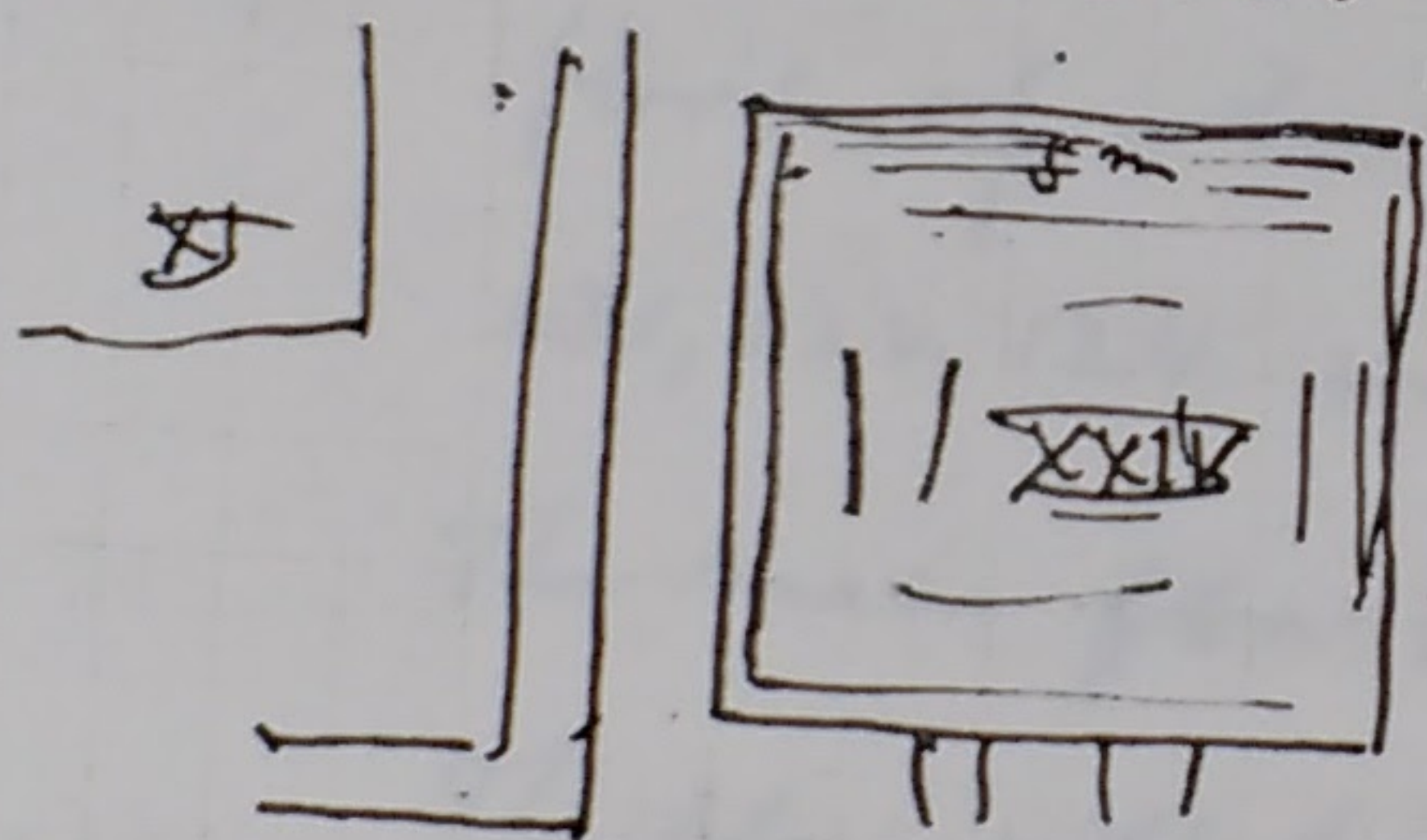

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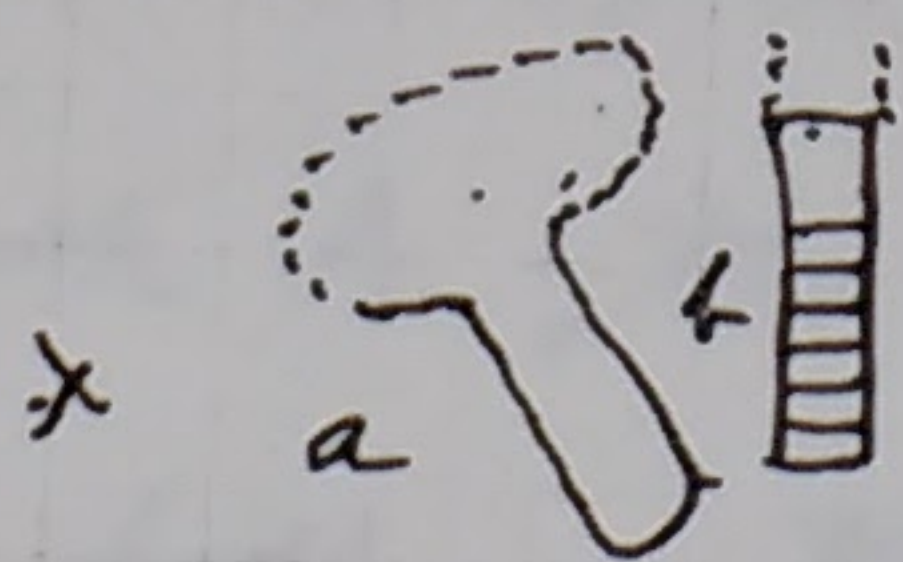
on account of the wind. But Egyptian

bad. Perhaps, having found the rock bad

the stair at b.
