(3) Pyr B VII. (4) Pyr B VIII. (No work on B V)

(1) B 501 EX 4 :--  
Feb 27th

Work continued clearing Westward as yesterday.

(2) B 501 EX 3 + :--  
Pylon II  
Feb 27th

Started clearing in area B 501 EX 3 along "N" end of Pylon II  
(between 501 and 502). Also cleared on top of preserved  
part of pylon here in order to clear up the joining on of  
"N" walls 501 and 502 to pylon.

The "NE" corner of the pylon  
which is exposed down to  
foundations shows step  
construction, not an inclined  
face. The steps still retain  
coating of plaster in places.

The "NE" corner of "N" wall of B 501 has a rounded moulding as  
indicated, the line of the foundation course being slightly pro-  
jecting. This wall was evidently built after the Pylon.

(3) Pyr. B. VII  
Feb. 27.

Have now cleared all of "W" face (incl. chapel),  
and "S" face with part of "N" face.  
The pyr. faces are greatly worn but appear to  
have been vertical without mouldings at corners.  
and with high courses (like IX).
