In going over the potsherds from the Pyramids, one finds a certain number of imported vessels,--cups resembling the so-called “Samian” and plates & cups identical to fabric and form with red glazed wares (red sigillata) found by us at Samaria (2nd cent BC-1st cent AD). but lacking the polish of the true Arretine. The two handled jars [DRAWING] show manifest Greek influence but I do not know any identical forms. The handles are not stamped. There is also an askos form [DRAWING]. A few sherds show a cursive inscription in black (Meroitic?) and a frag. of a fai. offering table shows a Meroitic inscription [DRAWING] etc.
