Clearing rooms 703 and 704. In 703 the granite altar is now clear. It is cracked across from RU [??] to GD. [??] corner. It is in the axis of the temple but does not appear to rest on an even floor. Floor appears disturbed. The uneven floor is covered with a tangled mass of fallen masonry. Many inscribed blocks (very poor work), some inscribed in relief (name of Atlanersa). These were apparently <u>reused</u> in the wall which was knocked down (i.e. the <u>restored</u> wall). In room 704, more frags. of statuettes—mostly very crude, of sandstone (seated man, apt, etc). Also gold foil, large fai. cylinders, bronze objects (uraeus etc), glass, etc. These objects are like those found in pyramid.
