March 4th (Cont.)

Work at Nuri Feb 8th to March 4th (1) Filling chambers in which there was standing water, at request of Sudan Sanitary Dep't.

On Feb 8th started a small gang of locals main supervision of Hassan Abul Yusser sealing up chambers of Nuri Pyrs. I, XIII, and XXVII, which contained water. The chamber of Pyr I was sealed by building a door block of stone[?], mud plastered, and banked up sand. Pyrs XIII and XXVII were sealed by filling stairway with sand so as to block the entrance. This work took 1 ½ days.

(2) Foundation deposits N. Pyr XV :--

On Feb 29th started clearing sand from over the corners of N. XV preparatory to searching for F. D.s.

On March 2nd the "SE" deposit was found and cleared.

The Deposit is under the 2nd stone of the f.c. on the "E" side, and consists of the following pottery vessels in a circular pit in "gebel"

The "NE" corner of Pyr is destroyed.

On March 4th Said went to Nuri and cleared the "NE" F.D. Here the pit was of D 39, the beaker a of D 22. No saucer (b) was found, but in addition to the beaker <u>a</u> only a potsherd.

Thorough search by Said failed to reveal the two "W" deposits, but the search continues.
