Friday at 5 A.m. Said set off with the boxes to Shellal

May 10 Mursi stayed to mail a letter etc.

at 1:35, Said arrived at Luxor—and transferred the
boxes to car 4108 and telegraphed me.

at 3:30 Mursi arrived and the --- went on <to> Keft
arrived Keft at 7:10 and each went home.

“and this is the end of the Diary” (Said).
