I have put in four pits a.b.c.d in the low ground west of the "bank of debris" and four (a'b'c'd') in the edge of the "bank of debris". In the trenches a-d there is about 100-120 cm of dark (dry) dust and dirt with some potsherds; below this comes loose red sand, probably natural deposit. In <u>b</u>, a rough rubble wall (20 cm high) in <u>dirt</u> runs E-W.

In the trenches a'-d', dirt, drifted dust, tec. The white pebbles are only on the surface, and this gives a deceptive appearance
