(Jan. 29)

After careful consideration, I can only offer 50 LE for the lot.

Col. Jackson was giving a farewell <u>lunch</u> to Mr. Warder and asked us to stay to lunch. Six Egyptian officials made a table of ten. All but one Egyptian drank beer, as they do in Egypt.

Left about 4:00 for Kareima.

When we arrived at the "Kirbekan" found Arabi Ridwan with a broken leg (femur) (temporarily splinted by Said Ahmed). Now about 5 p.m. Got Arabi on an angareb¹¹ into the launch and Dunham took him down to Merowe to hospital. Mutawalli stayed with him.

Afterwards rode over to P.O.¹² and got our mail.

Dunham saw Arabi into hospital; and after seeing the doctor put on a splint and getting doctor's report, he came back, arriving about 8 p.m.
