It will be of considerable interest if we can get evidences of the date of the various restorations.

Going over the ground W. of the <u>Temple</u> (500) with Said, saw clear evidences of <u>recent</u> sebaḥ digging (just before we arrived). These excavated areas lighten the task of finding a dumping place. I selected an excavated apot near the S end of Blg. 600, near the granite monolith of Atlanersa [DRAWING: cartouche], for examination preliminary to examining this part of 600.

Friday Feb. 25 29th working day

Governor Jackson, Mr. Cameron, Mr. Young and Mr. Atkinson came to see the excavations. Mrs. Reisner gave them tea in the Mut temple. Came and returned in the launch.
