(Jan. 26) Pyr. IX has about 4 courses of rough block masonry at the bottom and on this stood the core of small rough stones and sandy dirt.

A hole in the middle of the S. side enters the core and penetrates into the hard sand above the stairway, but it is not yet clear whether it reached the chamber [apparently a <u>modern unsuccessful</u> attempt to reach the chamber].

No trace of chapel preserved
