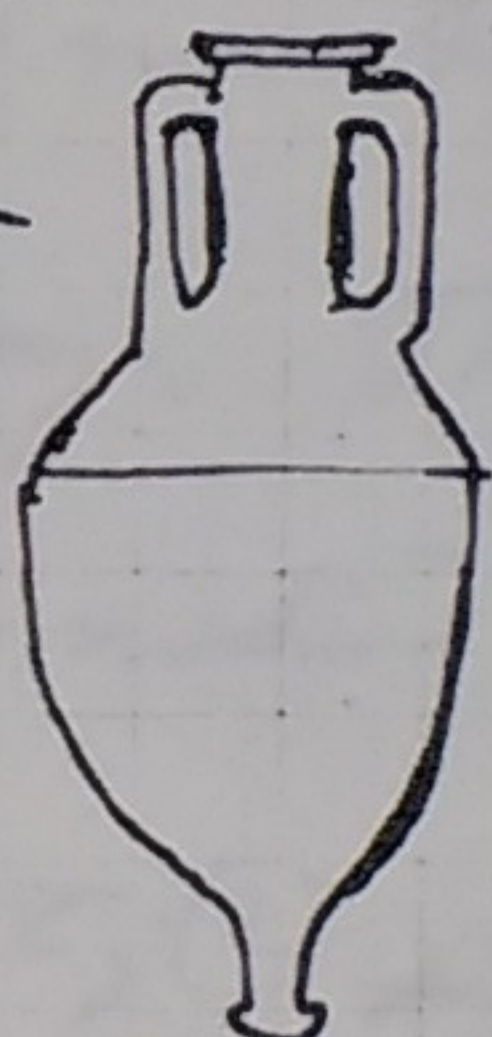

In going over the potsherds from the Pyramids, one finds a certain number of imported vessels, - cups resembling the so-called "Samian" and plates ^{cups} identical in fabric and form with red glazed wares (red sigillata) ~~Assyria~~ found by us at Samaria (~~2nd cent B.C.~~ 2nd cent B.C. - 1st cent AD).

but lacking the polish of the true Antioch.

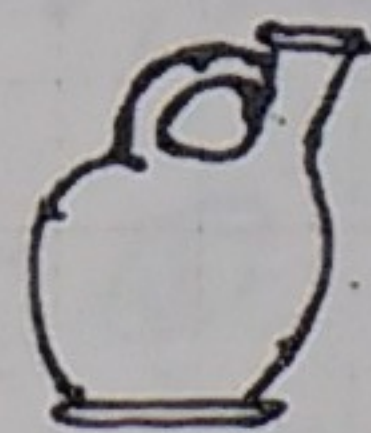
The two-handled jars ~~also~~ show manifest Greek influence do not know any identical

There is also an Askos form

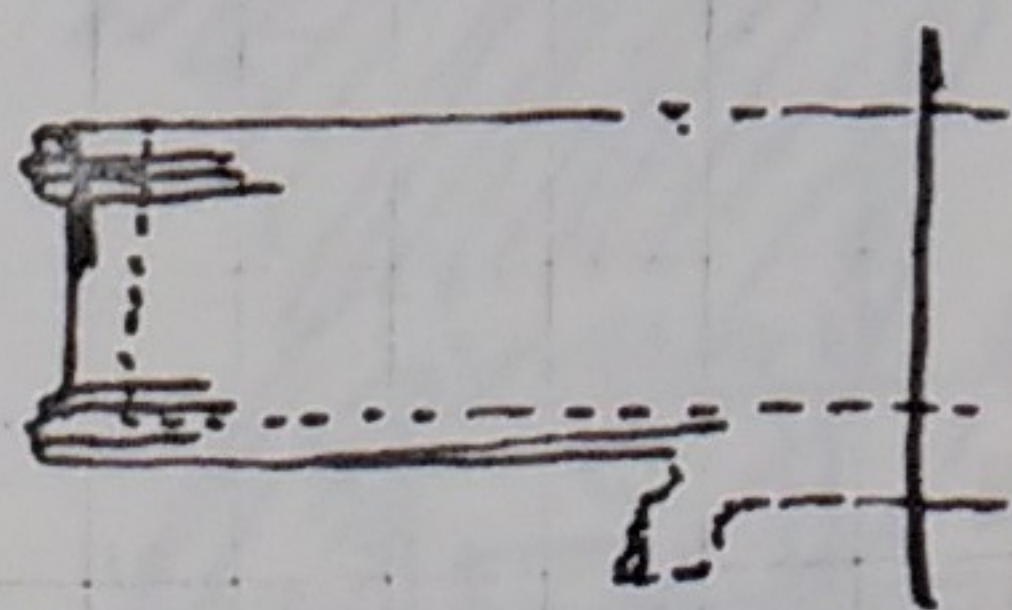


A few shreds show a cursive
