(1) B 502
Feb. 17

Clearing VIII 1, 2, VI 2. In VIII 1 the "S" wall is appearing the inside layer of stones have fallen in.

[Drawing]

- (a) dark dirty debris
- (b) layer of coals, ashes, etc.
- (c) drift sand, fallen stones.
- (d) an abacus from col. VII a (?)

This abacus is like that reported on Jan. 12, in 502 "SW" (actually 502 X 1) which lies about 10m → "W", [Drawing: hieroglyphs] and on another side [Drawing: hieroglyphs] (i.e. Nekhbet) It is quite clear that this is not the name of a king.
