Sunday

Feb 29th 1920: -- 100 ½ Locals.

71st Day of work: -- Work on (1) B 501 areas II 7 and III 7, (2) B 501 EX 4,

(3) B 501 EX 3, (4) Between B 800 + 850, (5) B 801. (6) Pyr BV

(1) B 501, II 7 + III 7: --Feb 29th Cleared away dumping ramp in B 501 II 7 + III 7, left from the clearing of this room. Burnt brick complex of house walls continues here as in the remainder of 501. Fragments of sheet bronze and 2 frags of alabaster jar [Drawing] from between house walls.

(2) B 501 EX 4 : --Feb 29th Continued as yesterday and also working "E" at about 10 m. "N" from door, towards railway line.

(3) B 501 EX 3 : --Feb 29th Work clearing top of "N" exterior wall of B 501 between doorway and Pylon II 500.

(4) Bet. B 800 + 850. Feb 29th Work was undertaken to discover nature of area between "W" face of Pylon I 800 and the mud brick building 850. At "SE" corner of B 850 removing mud debris with blocks and frags of sandstone fallen between the two buildings. The "W" face of Pylon I 800 is hidden by a later rubble wall built against it, and ca. 3 m. "W" of this a roughly built wall running "NS" of large red sandstone blocks and rubbish (late.)

(5) B 801
Feb 29th
* in order to clear
away debris under it, and
found in this debris --

Clearing in "S" half of B 801 for purposes of measurement. Moved the large granite frag inscribed Atlanersa* fragmentary block of yellow-brown sandstone with red streaks, apparently a block of square form from over the cap. of a column. Actual measurement 83 x 92 cm., but was originally ca. 92 x 92 (traces of 2 opposite faces), and about 1 Ell in height (ca 52 cm.) On one face corner of a cartouche of Piankhy.

All 4 faces were inscribed like the [Drawing: Hieroglyphs] larger abaci of the great temple. But this is not from Great Temple.
