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surface (red sand). Removed thorn

bush beside the black-brown stone step

altar (decorated [Drawing]). There were

five or six great roots, the largest ca 12 cm

in diameter. Tunnelled through "great

bank" and cut roots underground.

Continued heartbreaking work in the

great rect. pit. Estimate now over 200 cubic meters.

Continued in rooms 1221-1223 etc.
