Work on (1) Pylon I B 500, (2) B 501 EX 3, (3) B 551 III 3,  
(4) B 903, (5) "N" of B 802, (6) Pyrs B XXVI + XXVII.

(1) Pylon I B 500 : --  
March 27th

Work continued clearing "N" end and face of Pylon. Also  
worked clearing on top of "N" half of Pylon, partially clearing  
stair from B 501 to top of Pylon.

(2) B 501 EX 3  
March 27th

Work continued as yesterday.

(3) B 551 III<sup>3</sup> : --  
March 27th

Further clearing undertaken here to uncover third granite  
ram in the "N" row, which was lying on its side immediately  
"W" of its pedestal. About two meters "West" of this ram found  
a number of frags of two grey granite stelae with Meoritic  
inscription. One of these frags. shows part of the rough hewn  
base, and shows traces of inscribed surface behind.

(4) B 903 : --  
March 27th

Examined foundations of the early mud-brick temple wall at  
this point. The same foundation of smallish white sandstone  
blocks roughly thrown together but not laid regularly as under the  
m. b. wall in B 904. One of these blocks observed with frag.  
of inscription, a cartouche of Ramses II.

(5) "N" of B 802 : --  
March 27th

Continued examination of early mud brick walls at this point.

(6) Pyrs B. XXVI + XXVII  
March 27th

Finished clearing stairway of XXVI, the door block broken  
away by thieves + the chamber filled with debris. Stair of  
Pyr XXVII located + partly cleared
