- (8) Preliminary trenching S and E of the Gt Temple. Opposite centre of 1<sup>st</sup> Pylon located corner of sandstone wall. Trench E of 1<sup>st</sup> Pylon down ca 1.50 with loamy brown sand at bottom. Line of stone wall running NS. R.P. potsherds, and grey ware handle [DRAWING]. Hassan reports some human bones, but they could not be found for examination. Trench E of Northern part of temple, in ground containing great quantity of potsherds [DRAWING] bases of painted bet.[?] jars of blk ware, pinkish grey ware frags. of large jars, etc. Trench EW ca 1 metre down to gebel. Burnt brick wall running N.S. at W end of trench. In trench small frag. of thin bronze, bent.
