Tuesday April 18 74th working day. [86th day at Barkal]

Am preparing to leave next Monday April 24. As the wood for cases has not arrived, Said and some men will have to stay on to complete the packing of the statues which by agreement with Mr. Crowfoot are to stay in our house at Kareima.

Work on (1) 900; (2) 503 and 504; (3) Nuri

- (1) At 900 cleared the rooms 907, 908 to the old stone pavement. In the <u>dumped</u> debris in the rooms, several light fai. offering jars [DRAWING] and other small objects. These jars are probably of the same use as the pottery jars of similar form (brit[X?] two c[X?] crucibles). These rooms appear to have been accessing rooms of the old mud-brick temple 800 sub.
- (2) Clearing rooms 503 and 504. Debris as before. Also cleaning up the rest of the rooms 509-520.
- (3) At Nuri, as it is impossible to penetrate room 3 in Pyr. VIII (owing to the fall fo the roof) until the rotten rock and debris is cut away from above, I decided to postpone
