Work on, -- (1) B 200 (2) B 300  
 (3) B 500  
 (4) B 503 EX. "N"  
 (5) B 502 EX. "S"  
 (6) B 1200.

(1) B 200

Jan. 20.

Exposed whole face of rock up to "N" wall of B 300. Remains some debris "W" of small masonry retaining wall.

Cut trenches in plain in front of B 200 running] in → "E" as far as present[?] excavation. But found original gebel at depth of 40-80 cm. No trace of walls --f. trenches or masonry.

(2) B 300

Jan. 20.

Having exposed "N" wall of 302 in excavation B 200 front, started three trenches about fifty meters out in plain and worked → "E" along line of "N" wall and "N" row of cols. Gebel found everywhere at depth of 10 to 80 cm. In deeper end about 30m. from rock in B 200 front began to find inscribed blocks in deeper debris, but f. c. of wall still destroyed.

All this front area of B 300 has been denuded below foot of walls and may be used as dumping ground.

(3) B 500

Jan. 20.

Work continued on hard debris in 502 "West".

I worked on minute examination of B 503. Making new plan.

(4) B 503 EX "N".

Jan. 20.

Exposed area up to back ("E") of pylon III, dumping inside area enclosed in rubble wall. Then worked → "N" and at sunset reached edge of excavation of 1916. The litter of broken stones has been turned over and over by Modern taking sebak and stones. The surface is uneven scarred with sebak holes. The basis is red sand (gebel). Killed a snake.
