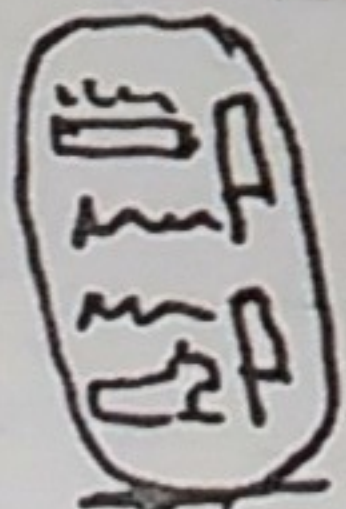
Left at 7:45 for Barkul. (43)

 the frags. of statues from French
 A of Bly. 500, beginning with
 smaller fragments.

Head no. 2 belongs to statue no. 1
 (Aspalut). Two other pieces (from
 lying beside Taharka statue and
 shoulder under No. 6) fit on the
 Aspalut statue making it practically
 complete.

Head no. 1 of grey granite and some
 other frags. (beside Taharka and under
 No. 6) belong to statue no. 5. The
 statue is not complete, (the chin notably
 is missing. We were not able

to turn No. 5 over until No. 4 is
 moved. Therefore the name is not yet
 completely clear.
