(3) B 900 : --Feb 28th This afternoon partially removed rough red sandstone + rubbish wall runnin "NS" over 906, 907 + 908. This made it possible to get the plane of the room 906 complete, the central portion formerly having been hidden under this later wall.

The exterior "S" wall of B 900, opposite 904-6-10 was observed to be of two periods. The older with projecting f.c. and with bonded wall of header + stretcher courses, the later wall being a sheathing of the former, also with a projecting f.c., above the 1st f.c.

The cross hatched ([Drawing]) blocks are the later sheathing wall and f.c.

(4) B 800 Pylon I Feb 28th Cleared the "S" side of doorway in Pylon I B 800 for purposes of measurement and comparison with "N" side already cleared. The door is <u>not</u> centred on "EW" axis of room 801, but has its centre slightly "N" of the centre line.

(5) Pyr BV Feb 28th Work clearing around chapel walls for measurements.
