Work on (1) R. side of 900; (2) 503; (3) 519, GD corner; (4) Nuri.

Having photographed the mud-brick rooms with high floors which lie just to R. side of 905, proceeded to cut out floors without disturbing walls.

(2)

Clearing 503. Older walls appearing underneath and on U. side, older pavements one of which consisted of blue-glazed tiles. In general the Lepsius plan is more correct than Cailliaud's but we are now able to replace it by a plan which takes account of the chronology of the temple. Of the bases between the cols. in 503, only one is still in place. It is of badly weathered red sandstone. In the U. side of 503, is a curious cap-stone [DRAWING]<sup>66</sup> with decorations (religious) in relief and the name of [DRAWING: cartouche] (Brugsch Bouriant No. 182) the late
