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of Abdullah Abu Gebel and Abd-el-Azim Tantawi.

At Qus, a man brought news that Mohammed (the village <u>Hakeem</u>) father of Ashur died last night. So I let Ashur get off at Qeft and ordered Sahim Hasan [?] to give up his vacation and come on to Cairo. Atitu [?] the dish washer joined us at Keft.

Saturday April 29

Arrived at Cairo at 7:45 having lad breakfast in the train (coffee prepared by Sahim at Shellal, hot rich milk bought by sleeping car conductor at Wasta, and the remains of our lunch basket). Found Saduq with three other of our boys waiting for us and took a taxi out to Mena House, bringing the antiquities in my suit case. Found Qarqar and four others waiting. Hafez brought us four donkies and we rode up to the camp, which we reached before 9 a.m. Dunham stayed in town, engaging passage to America.

Saturday

May 6 Mr. Kemp accompanied by Refai arrived.

Monday

May 8 Dunham left to take the Bitby [??] boat for Marseilles, going to America.
