

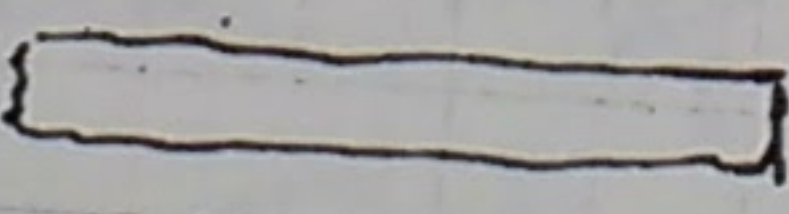

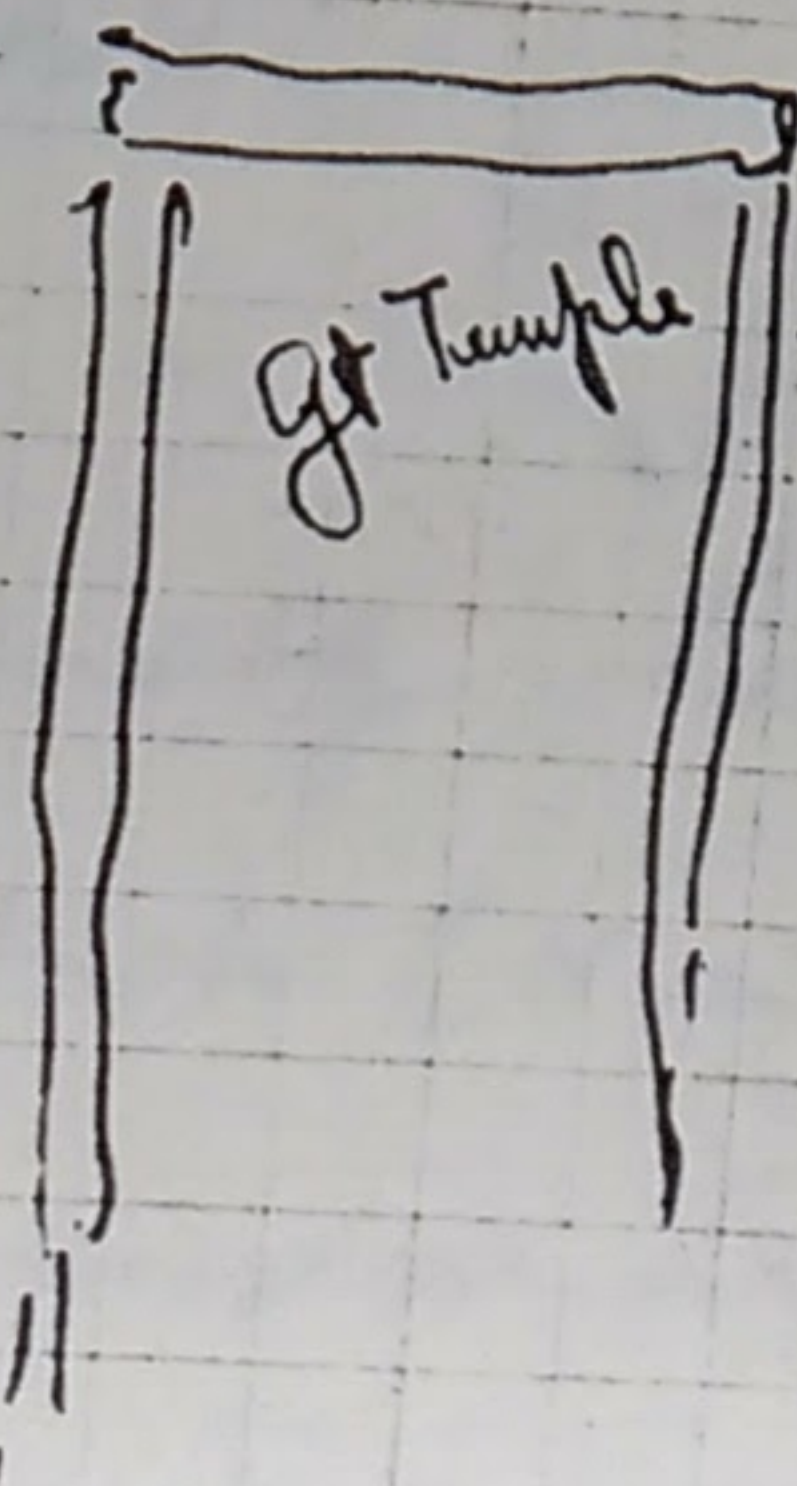
Preliminary trenching S and E of the 99th 98th
Gt Temple. Opposite centre of 1st Pylon located
corner of sandstone wall. Trench E of 1st Pylon
down ca 1.50, with loamy brown sand at bottom. Line of
stone wall running N.S. R.P. potsherds, and grey ware
handle . Hassan reports some human bones, but
they could not be found for examination. Trench E
of Northern part of temple, in ground containing great
quantity of potsherds  bases of painted bet. jars of
blue ware, pinkish grey ware frags. of large jars,
etc. Trench E W ca 1 metre down to gebel.
Burnt brick wall running N.S. at W end of trench.
In trench small frag. of thin bronze, bent.

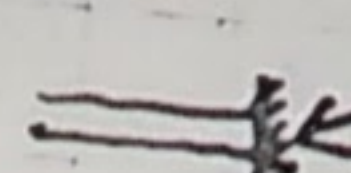
