Left at 8:15 in motor launch for ²⁴67/68
Merroe with Lunham. Arrived 8:50
(i.e. 35 minutes): led. Jackson had
boxes etc belonging to Prof. Griffith taken
out of store room and opened. Everything
was in confusion, partly due to original
packing by Is. Saw about $\frac{3}{4}$ of stuff
by Brown. Opened samples of tinned
food, - meats, biscuits, cheese and much
other material spoiled. Flour and
cereals, doubtful. Many books eaten
clean through by white ants. Baskets
attacked by white ants. Blankets
partly moth-eaten. Folding tables, -
some shrunk and cracked; largest table
broken (can be mended). Bed frame boxes
appear all right but are mostly too large
for our uses. R.R. equipment too
small to be of much use (4 carts, 100 miles).
One white tent missing. The duplication of
material is unwise - 8 T-squares; 4 saws;
chairs for two ~~to~~ or three expeditions, etc.
